2. Volunteers should remember that they represent the Library and should always be courteous to library patrons and staff regardless of age.

Parent volunteers are chosen at the discretion of the Head of Youth Services.

- 3. Volunteers should wear appropriate attire to the library and wear a library nametag during their shift.
- 4. Volunteers will arrive on time and notify a staff member when they arrive.
- 5. Volunteers must keep their cell phones in their pocket on vibrate and must not make or receive any calls that are not emergencies.
- 6. Volunteers may take a 5-minute break whenever necessary, as long as they tell a staff member where they are going.
- 7. Volunteers will perform duties as assigned in a pleasant manner. Any questions related to duties should be directed to Youth Services staff.
- 8. Volunteers must keep socializing to a minimum.
